
We believe that un-like a traditional Golf Course **Fly Links** courses could be designed to have no negative impact on the sustainability of restored areas.





 - No longer a whole day's event.


...And a concept is born

A newly restored stream whose water can support a trophy cold-water fishery and whose new oxbow ponds can support trophy warm-water fisheries.


Fish from both water types are present on the same property and ready to be caught!

How can we ensure a fisherman gets a chance at every hole?



We divvy up the fishing spots into groups which can be thought of as "holes".

If we label each hole numerically, we can create a path for fishermen to follow around the property... enabling them every opportunity for a hook-up while they create their own adventure along the way.




The path to tight lines, bent rods, and fish landed!
